You have probably been contacted by Trilogy Integrated Resources regarding the Network of Care which will be available for every county mental health program.

Network of Care is a website designed to provide information about each county program and all of its providers, support efforts of consumers and families toward successful recovery, link to extensive resources about mental health, track bills in the Pennsylvania legislature and Congress and make contact with legislators.

Network of Care is a state of the art system that was praised as a model in the President's New Freedom Commission on Mental Health report. It was created and is managed by Trilogy Integrated Resources and is strongly supported by the National Association of County Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities Directors (NACBHDD) which is an affiliate of NACo and of which we are members. Philadelphia and Bucks Counties have already purchased the Network of Care, as have counties in other states.

We are especially grateful to Deputy Secretary Joan Erney, who has agreed to purchase the set-up of the system and the first three years of operations. She has provided the funds through an allocation to Dauphin County which has contracted with the County Commissioners Association of Pennsylvania which has contracted with Trilogy.

MH/MR PAAP and Deputy Secretary Erney have worked for two years toward this goal and it is finally nearing reality.

Kathy Sterbenc of Trilogy is in charge of the implementation and Trilogy will be requesting and entering information about your county program, providers, and support organizations into the system.
